


EQUIS ERS Standard – Ch. 9

- **▼ Ethics, Responsibility and Sustainability**
 - A "globally responsible citizen"
 - School's ERS strategy
 - summary of evidence that ERS is reflected in mission, governance, strategy and operations
 - summary of coverage in programmes and R&D
 - **★** formal commitments (e.g. UN PRME)
 - **▼** ERS-related contribution to local & global communities
 - School's community and public outreach activities

Changes in EQUIS Standards

- **7** Ch. 1 − Context, Governance & Strategy
 - integration ERS in mission and vision
 - coverage of ERS in strategy / communication of strategy / resources allocation in support of strategy
- **7** Ch. 2 − Programmes
 - integration of ERS in design, delivery and assessment of programmes
 - **▼** ERS-dedicated programmes, coverage in others



Changes in EQUIS Standards

7 Ch. 3 − Students

- integration of ERS in student recruitment, admissions and student management (e.g. scholarship policy)
- integration of ERS in personal development of students
- (extra-)curricular student engagement related to ERS

7 Ch. 4 − Faculty

- **ERS** coverage in faculty training and development
- support for faculty engagement related to ERS



Changes in EQUIS Standards

- **7** Ch. 5 − Research
 - coverage of ERS in research, development and innovation
- **7** Ch. 6 − Executive Education
 - ERS-dedicated activities, coverage in others
- **7** Ch. 7 − Resources
 - integration of ERS in infrastructure planning and management (e.g. waste, energy), operations (e.g. purchasing) and administration (e.g. workforce diversity)
 - ERS coverage in staff training and development
- **7** Ch. 10 − Corporate Connections
 - contributions to ERS development of businesses and practices

Financial Performance/Management

- Purpose
 - *improve comprehensiveness and clarity of financial data provided*
 - enable PRTs to focus on analysis and interpretation rather than fact finding
- Provision of data for past 5 years as well as budget figures for next 3 years.
 - consolidated income statement and cash flow statement (latter if available), assets and liabilities
 - other agreements affecting availability of financial resources
 - budgeting process
 - Internal financial controls, KPI's, stakeholder reports

- Purpose
 - expanded coverage of risk dimension, coverage of non-financial risks
- I. Organisation of the risk management function
- II. Risk management process in practice
- III. Risk mitigation



EQUIS Developments in 2014

- Special Re-accreditation
 - Pilot phase completion by 2014
 - Initial positive feedback
- Revised Policy on :
 - Multi-campus Operations


